REAR LOWER CONTROL ARM BUSH

INSTALLATION GUIDE

Contents (parts per pack):

8 x Polyurethane Bushes 1 x PTFE/Silicone Grease 4 x Stainless Steel Sleeves 8 x Mild Plated Washers

Please read the complete fitting instructions and check package components before fitment. These fitting instructions are to be used as a guide and in conjunction with workshop manual. It is recommended that:

- -all work to be carried out by a licensed technician;
- -all safety precautions adhered to;
- -wheel alignment to be checked and adjusted as required after any suspension work.
- -All fasteners must be tensioned to manufacturer's torque settings.

Fitting Instructions:

- 1. Remove the rear control arm from the car, taking care to retain the original fasteners.
- 2. Using a press tool, remove the original bushes from both ends of the arm.
- 3. Wipe away any rust and dirt from the bores of the arm.
- 4. Push the Polyurethane bushes into the arm.
- 5. Apply some of the supplied grease to bore of the Polyurethane bushes and to the outside of the metal sleeves.
- 6. Using the original fasteners and the supplied washers, refit the strut into the mounting brackets on the car.
- 7. Tighten all fasteners to manufacturer recommendations.
- 8. Repeat the process for the control arm on the opposite side of the car.
